

14U PNW Championship Rules

This is a 5 game guaranteed tournament. It is being played using pool play and a championship bracket. Teams will be seeded after pool play is completed. Trophies will be awarded to the PLAYERS for the top 2 teams along.

We will be charging \$5 per Adult/ \$2 Per Child 5-12 yrs. Old. Or a \$25 Family weekend pass (good for up to 4 people). Please be polite and courteous as this is standard procedure for these kind of tournaments. Its possible that we won't have a gate person at THPRD and Pacific (More to come).

Rules:

All High School Rules Apply.

All games are 7 innings or No new inning after 2 hours and 15 minutes. In pool play a tie after 7 complete innings or the time limit is reached is considered a complete game and a tie is recorded. On Sunday championship round ONLY a 7 inning tie will be played out if time allows. If the time limit has expired we will play up to two innings with the California rule. If that still doesn't break it we will revert to last untied inning. The championship will have no time limit and can not end in a tie if time permits. Tournament Director holds right to of all final decisions. On Saturday please have your team prepared to play 15 minutes before scheduled time. We have somewhat of a tight schedule and want to get as many innings for all.

All Teams will have the right the right to play 9 players with high school substitution rules. You can have a DH. If you want free substitution you must bat your ROSTER. It will be at the discretion of each Manager what his team chooses. I.E. one team could bat roster while other plays 9. Courtesy runners won't be allowed.

The 10 run rule after 5 is in effect, this rule includes the championship and 3rd place game.

Pitchers to pitch no more than 17 innings if teams starts on Thursday. 13 innings for the teams who begin on Friday. A pitcher may not exceed 7 innings in two consecutive games. If a pitcher pitches 7 full innings in any day he must have a day off between his next outing.
